

PUBLIC NOTICE

The MARION WATERWORKS is a public water system subject to regulation under the federal Safe Drinking Water Act. Those regulations require the notification of customers whenever a violation occurs, and is the basis for this notice.

Distribution system disinfectant chlorine residual must be monitored at the same time and place as when bacteriological compliances samples are collected. The residuals were not measured or the form documenting the residuals was not submitted to the ADH Engineering Section for the period of June 2021.

The U.S. Environmental Protection Agency sets standards for drinking water. Part of those regulations sets limits on the level of disinfectant which is allowed in the distribution system. Failure to meet this requirement does not necessarily mean that the water is unsafe or that alternate sources of water should be used.

The water system has been scanning & e-mailing the monthly Bacteriological Monitoring and Operations Reports to the AR Health Dept. We request a confirmation of receipt to ensure that our requirement date by the 10th has been met.
